

Supported Living Technician

Job Summary:

- To assist individuals with skills for daily living, increase their level of independence through training and support. Monitor and assist with daily needs and work collaboratively and cooperatively with the Supported Living Coach, Managers, Directors, and Support Coordinators.

Education / Experience:

- Must possess a High School Diploma, or GED.
- Minimum of one (1) year experience in working with in a medical, psychiatric, nursing or childcare setting or working with persons who have a developmental disability.

Qualifications:

- Must pass a Level II Background Screening.
- Must pass a drug test.
- Must have transportation, current license, current car registration, current car insurance, and a good driving record.
- Must be able to lift 50 lbs.
- Must be in good physical health.

Essential Job Functions:

- Assist with training consumer in all areas that are indicated on consumer's Individualized Support Plans.
- Responsible for progress notes and monthly tracking sheets.
- Assist in assessing consumer's abilities to perform daily living activities in actual environments where skills will ultimately be required and performed.
- Helps consumers maximize their capacities and bridge the gap between abilities and environmental demands by helping them develop skills, routines, and habits that will allow them as much control as possible over every day environments.
- Assists in personal care and daily living activities such as bathing, toileting, grooming, dressing, meal preparation, clothing care and maintenance and general health and safety issues.
- Performs ongoing developmental and behavioral assessments of consumers.
- Occasionally take or assist consumers with appointments, outings or shopping, as necessary.
- Protect each consumer's rights and freedoms, maintain the confidentiality of their personal information, and provide for and insure each individual's rights to privacy.
- Must follow Behavior Modification plans for each consumer designed by the Certified Behavior Analyst (CBA).
- Assists or maintains the consumer's home as a clean and safe environment. This includes heavy household chores such as washing floors, windows, walls, moving heavy items of furniture to make the home safer, etc.
- Perform other functions, as directed, relevant to the position.
